Learning Agreement

Rules:

- Incoming Students are not allowed to choose exams with similar course contents and learning outcomes, even though from different Degree Courses (for example: Fisica I and Fisica Generale I)
- 2. Changes to the Learning Agreement should be done within a month after the student's arrival
- 3. The Learning Agreement can be changed only once per semester
- 4. Online exams are not allowed
- 5. The dates of the mobility written on the Learning Agreement are binding (if the end of the mobility is planned for July 30th, the student is not allowed to take any exam at our Department after that date)
- 6. Write the correct name of the course in Italian
- 7. Write the contacts you find on this Fact Sheet in the appropriate section on your LA
- 8. Write the correct dates of your mobility
- 9. Write the course's codes: <u>https://www.esse3.unimore.it</u>
- 10. If your Erasmus lasts one semester, you are allowed to choose only courses available that semester (no annual courses)

On the left, click on: Menu -> Didattica -> Corsi di Laurea -> Ricerca Insegnamenti Select "Dipartimento di Scienze e Metodi dell'Ingegneria" in Facoltà/Dipartimento In the last line, write the name of the course and click "cerca"

For example: IG-020 - Gestione aziendale, the code is IG-020
